The Hartford Road sidewalk project is being completed with grant funding, allowing us to make an important pedestrian improvement while reducing the financial impact on Delran taxpayers. Work on the Pancoast Boulevard sidewalk project is also underway, along with roadway improvements throughout Millside.

The Summer Hill baseball field renovation project is now underway, a completion target date will be shared soon.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will also participate in an upcoming Township Council work session to discuss the ongoing Feasibility Study. We look forward to hearing their update and continuing the conversation about this important work.

Residents should also be aware that New Jersey American Water will be conducting system flushing throughout our area during September. Please keep an eye on Township communications for additional information and any updates that may affect your neighborhood.
