**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 299, SECTION 11 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
DELRAN'S MUNICIPAL CODE TO REGULATE THE LEAVES, GRASS, AND OTHER  
COMPOSTABLE MATERIALS FOR COLLECTION BY THE TOWNSHIP**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Delran has recognized that it is necessary to clarify the manner in which yard trimmings that are collected by the Township from Township residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council of the Township of Delran now desires to amend Chapter 299, Section 11 of the Township Code to clarify the manner in which yard trimmings shall be collected by the Township be collected by the Township; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Delran, in the County of Burlington and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 299, Section 11(G) of the Township Code shall be amended and shall read as follows:

G. Tree and shrubbery trimmings.

(1) Loose tree and shrubbery trimmings shall be collected by the Township from April 1 through October 15 of each year. No tree trunks, branches, limbs or shrubbery larger than four inches in diameter shall be collected. All trimmings shall be placed at the curbside in a manner so as not to cause obstruction of the public. No pile of yard trimmings bigger than four (4) Cubic Yards (12' Long x 3' High x 3' Wide) will be picked up. Piles of yard trimmings larger than allowed by this section will be left at the curbside and the residential user shall have ten (10) calendar days to dispose of the pile.

(2) Yard trimmings shall not be collected by the Township unless they meet the following criteria: 1) Uncut and left at full length and stacked with ends facing the same direction; 2) Contain no leaves or vines; 3) Piled in a neat and manageable condition as determined by the Collector; 4) Are equal to or less than four (4) inches in diameter.

(3) Residential users may not put out a pile of yard trimmings for collection for at least twenty-one (21) days from the last yard trimmings collection

(4) Tree and shrubbery branches, rootballs, tree stumps, limbs and trimmings cut by landscape or tree service contractors or other commercial workers, or resulting from land being cleared, or resulting from cut down trees, shall not be collected by the Township. Residential users with proof of address within the Township may bring the above-listed items to the public works yard for disposal during normal business hours and the first and third Saturday of the month, 8:00am

to 12:00pm. No rootball or tree stump that is greater than twelve-inches in diameter, 2.5 feet in length, or has a root mass of 20 square feet may be brought to the public works yard.

**Section 2. Repealer.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to said inconsistencies and conflict.

**Section 3. Severability.** If any section, part of any section, or clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Township Council of the Township of Delran declares that it would have passed the ordinance and each section and subsection thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** The ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection is promulgating recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the recycling regulations imposed on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including, but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, a resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for such tonnage grants for 2015 will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and indicate the assent of the Delran Township Council to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, such a resolution acknowledges that Jerry DeSanto is a Certified Recycling Professional to ensure that the application is properly completed and timely filed under the law.

**TAX REIMBURSEMENT CERTIFICATION**

**WHEREAS**, The Recycling Enhancement Act, P.L. 2007, chapter 311, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grants may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

**WHEREAS**, there is levied upon the owner or operator of every solid waste facility (with certain exceptions) a recycling tax of \$3.00 per ton on all solid waste accepted for disposal or transfer at the solid waste facility.

**WHEREAS**, whenever a municipality operates a municipal service system for solid waste collection, or provides for regular solid waste collection service under a contract awarded pursuant to the "Local Public Contracts Law", the amount of grant monies received by the municipalities shall not be less than the annual amount of recycling tax paid by the municipality except that all grant monies received by the municipality shall be expended only for its recycling program.
