**TOWNSHIP OF DELRAN
ORDINANCE 2021-21**

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SALARY RANGES FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELRAN, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND REGULATING THE MANNER OF PAYMENT OF SAME

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Delran in the County of Burlington and State of New Jersey that the Township does hereby establish the following salary ranges for the employees serving in the following position:

POSITIONS	Annual 2021 Salary Range	Pay Period	Effective Date
Chief of Police	\$125,000 - \$155,000	Bi Weekly	9/30/2021

Section II Repeal - All ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

Section III Adoption - This Ordinance shall take effect twenty days after final adoption and publication according to law. This Ordinance is retroactive respectively to September 30, 2021

Mr. Smith made a motion to open the meeting to the public, seconded by Mr. Jeney. All were in favor, motion approved.

Robert Brown, 20 Providence Court asked what the ordinance was for.

Mr. Burrell stated that the ordinance allows for a salary range for the new Chief of Police. The exact salary will be set by Resolution.

Mr. Brown asked how much additional taxes for taxpayer will pay.

Mr. Hatcher stated that we had the Chief of Police retire, the new salary will be somewhat similar so there should be no impact.
