2020 Delran Municipal Budget

Overview of the 2020 municipal budget and 5 year history of past budgets

Delran Township Budget Process

- The 2020 budget process began in October of 2019 with the department heads meeting with administration to examine the costs and processes necessary to deliver the service needs of the community.
- This culminated in the Mayor submitting his budget to the Township Council on February 25th 2020 for their review.
- Township Council reviewed the budget at work sessions through the month of March and, due
 to the declared emergency in regard to COVID-19, the State of New Jersey extended the
 budget deadlines.
- The Township Council introduced the budget on May 5, 2020 and scheduled a public hearing on June 2, 2020.
- The resulting municipal budget calls for no tax increase and no sewer rate increase.

2020 Municipal Budget

- The budget calls for no increase in taxes!
- Appropriations less than 2019
- Spending Plan below the state cap on appropriations
- Tax Levy Cap below the state cap on taxes
- Sewer Budget No Rate Increase (10th year in a row)

Delran Net Valuation

- Delran has a Net Valuation Taxable of \$1,425,281,690.
- This is the total valuation of all properties within the Township of Delran that are subject to property taxes.
- Each penny of the tax rate yields \$142,528.

The Big Picture Tax Rate Impact on Tax Payers

- "What is the impact of an increase or decrease on the average residential tax payer?"
- From the Tax Collectors book there are 5,170 homes in Delran with a total valuation of \$1,095,433,100 for an average assessment of \$211,882 per home in Delran.
- Based upon this information each penny on the tax rate represent an average homeowner \$21.18 per year, since the tax rate is per thousand of the assessment.
- This Municipal Budget calls for no tax increase!

Delran Municipal Tax rate in 2020

Utilizing this years tax rate and this years average assessment the average home in Delran pays \$1,631 for the municipal tax rate and \$48.60 for the open space tax.

These are the only funds that the Township of Delran keeps from the property tax bill. The remaining portions of your property tax bill is determined by and paid to the School, the County and the Fire District.

This municipal budget calls for **no tax increase**. So, the rate will remain the same.

Delran Municipal Tax Rate since 2016 5 Budgets

- The Tax Rate in 2016 was .764 Cents and the Tax Rate 5 years later is .791 cents
- The total increase in the Municipal Tax Rate has been 2.7 cents over the last 5 years.
- In the last five years the Municipal Tax Increase in the average home has been \$57.19. (\$11.43/Year).
- Remember: The Municipal Rate represents just 21.9 percent of the total property tax bill in Delran.






Chart of 5 Year Spending by Category
